BOARDING TERMS & CONDITIONS

The APPR is a Guinea Pig Rescue and Foster Care program that offers boarding services, as space is available, to help support our rescue efforts. 100% of all proceeds from boarding services go directly to the rescue.

All APPR caretakers are thoroughly screened and trained in Cavy husbandry. We offer Piggie-Poo expertise and extremely high standards of care to all of our guests: fosters, rescues and boarders alike. We have volunteers throughout the Valley and generally have a boarding center near you.

While in our care, your piggies will not be mixed with the other boarders or foster piggies, except for its own bonded family.

Housing:

Guinea Pigs boarding with us are housed in C&C cage (www.cavycages.com), a MAXIMUM of 4 Guineas to a cage. We provide all the supplies needed to keep your piggies comfortable, however all of our guests are absolutely encouraged to bring their own hidey huts, water bottles, cozies and toys.

Should bonded pets require to be separated in the interest of the animals own safety, you will be charged accordingly for the additional accommodations.

Supplies provided (*when available*):

- C & C (Cube & Coroplast) Cage
- Feed Dish
- Water Bottle
- Hidey Hut / Pigloo
- Bedding
- Pellets
- Hay

Handling:

We ensure that all of our guests are given daily "floor time" in our play pens. They are also given a brief "health check" and are held and cuddled twice a day, just before meal times.

Feeding:

Any special dietary requirements are accommodated; however depending on extend of the requirements, a small charge may be applied. If your piggie is feed sensitive, please provide your own pellets.

- A fresh **salad** is fed every morning and consists of a mix of greens (kale, spinach, parsley, romaine, cilantro), vitamin C supplement (bell peppers, orange), and occasional treats of carrot, apple, pear, peach, grapes, blueberries, watermelon, tomatoes, banana, cucumber, strawberry, and corn silks and husks when in season.
- KMS Timothy Choice or Oxbow Cavy Cuisine **Pellets** are fed in the evening. If you have a very young Cavy that required Alfalfa pellets, then KMS Alfalfa Complete or Oxbow Cavy Performance will be fed.
- High quality second or third cut **Timothy Hay** is free fed all day long.

Bedding:

APPR offers two bedding options:

- The rescue uses **Kiln Dried Pine** almost exclusively, spot cleaned daily and completely changed and disinfected once a week.
- We also offer our boarders the option of fleece or towels over newspaper, changed and washed daily, for an additional charge.

Health Issues:

If your cavy shows any signs of illness, we will call you immediately at your emergency number. If we are not able to reach you for 4 hours, we will seek the advice of your Vet or APPR's Vet of Record, Dr. Bill Langhofer, Scottsdale Veterinary Clinic.

You will be held responsible for all Veterinary costs and you must have a credit card number on file with the APPR in the event of a medical emergency.

If your guinea pig requires medication or any special treatment, please let us know at the time of booking. We will do our best to accommodate their needs and note that additional charges may apply.

At present there are no vaccination requirements for guinea pigs, however it is good practice to provide annual anti-parasitic treatments. We reserve the right to refuse any animal which is showing signs of illness or disease.

We also reserve the right to refuse any heavily pregnant sows who may give birth during the boarding period, unless previously agreed prior to boarding.

Death of Your Cavy:

In the unlikely event of a death occurring, we will notify you immediately, and we will take your pet to either your Vet or APPR's Vet of Record, where you can arrange your final wishes.

The APPR will not be held liable for the death or illness of your cavy while in our care, unless by gross negligence as determined by a licensed Veterinarian.

Opening Times

We are network of private foster homes. We are open by appointment only, however we are usually able to accommodate most arrival and departure arrangements.

Deposit and Payment

To ensure your space, a 50% non-refundable deposit is payable at the time of booking with the balance to be paid upon arrival. Boarding fees are paid in cash or by PayPal on our website.

Delivery and Collection

All cavies should arrive and depart in a suitable pet carrier along with any possessions that make them feel at home.

We offer pick-up and delivery service within 10 miles of the boarding facility in your area for an additional charge. Please request this service at time of booking.

If your pet guinea pig is not collected within 2 days of the agreed upon pick-up date and you have not contacted us to inform us differently, we reserve the right to take action to have the animal re-homed. We also reserve the right to charge your credit card on file any and all outstanding boarding fees and other costs, or to undertake legal action to reimburse those same charges.

Boarding Rates

- Our rates start at \$10 per day per cage or \$60 a week (one day free), maximum of 4 piggies per cage.
- Special Dietary Requirements: up to \$5 per day per piggie, depending on the extent
- Fleece/Towel Bedding: \$5 per day per cage
- Administration of Medication: up to \$5 per day per piggie, depending on the extent

Additional Services:

- Grooming (bath, brushing, ear cleaning, nail clipping): \$5 per piggie per service
- Perineal Sac/Penis – Boars Only: (thorough cleaning of the anal sac and penis, warm water soaks and/or flushes, and lubrication of the sac with mineral oil) **May be required daily for Males showing signs of impaction** \$5 per piggie per service
- Anti-parasitic Treatments: Ivermectin* (Mites) & Imidacloprid (Lice) \$10 per piggie
**to be effective against mites and other parasites, IVERMECTIN treatments must be administered in 3 doses, 7 to 10 days apart. The APPR will provide follow-up treatments for no additional cost at our main adoption center in Anthem North, during regularly scheduled Adoption Days.*

Please note:

APPR, Inc., its Directors, Members and Volunteers are not Veterinarians. We cannot diagnose or treat any injuries, illnesses or disease. Please see your Vet immediately if you think your pet may be sick or hurt.

At this moment in time, no licensing laws or regulations exist in respect of boarding small animals.

All animals are left entirely at their owner's risk.
